Spring Scavenger Hunt-Home Edition!

1. Find a BIG or little puddle:

Guide Questions:

Where is it?

Is it in a shady spot or a sunny spot?

Where did the water come from? Where does it go when it's gone?

Activity: Check your puddle every day for a week. Check it at different times of day (early morning vs. afternoon). Does it stay the same? Why or why not?

2. Find 3 (or more) different colors of flower:

Guide Questions:

Why do flowers have bright colors?

Do insects and other pollinators have 'favorite' flowers?

Activity: 'Dissect' a flower. Help your child take a flower apart and draw and label parts.

3. Find and draw 3 signs of spring:

Guide Questions:

How do we know it's spring?

Can you name all 4 seasons? Which is your favorite and why?

Activity: Plant spring seeds like peas and radishes. If you don't have outdoor space, peas will grow in any container on a porch or a windowsill!

5. Find an insect- what kind is it?

Guide Questions:

What's the difference between an insect and a bug?

Where can we find insects?

Activity: Build an insect with found objects (either household items or items from nature found outside)
